



YES TO A PALESTINIAN STATE ! RELEASE OF ALL CHILDREN IMPRISONED BY ISRAEL RELEASE OF POLITICAL PRISONERS

FNIC-CGT and TUI Chemistry Energy give their full support to the Palestinian people and demand the release of dozens of Palestinian children currently held in Israeli prisons as well as that of more than 4 500 political prisoners.

FNIC CGT and TUI Chemistry Energy now advocate the creation of an independent Palestinian state, within the 1967 borders and with East Jerusalem as its capital. It also demands the end of settlements and the Israeli occupation.

Since 2000, an estimated 12 000 Palestinian children have been arrested by Israeli forces in the occupied West Bank and detained in Israeli military prisons, many of which are no more than 12 years old. In some cases, even children between the ages of 6 and 7 have been imprisoned by the military. Israel brings 500 to 700 Palestinian

children to military courts each year, while on average 200 to 300 children are held in Israeli prisons per month.

Palestinian workers and children are being arrested because they oppose the Israeli occupation of their territories and Israel's criminal policy, which places restrictions on them on a daily basis and constantly threatens their health and lives.

Palestinian prisoners are faced with violence and intimidation, administrative detention, solitary confinement, neglect of their health and lack of vaccination during the COVID-19 pandemic and we can all imagine the consequences of these conditions of detention on a child's mental and physical health.

Israel must immediately put an end to these criminal actions and violations of international conventions on the rights of the child.
